On Wednesday evening, June 15th, we will have an opportunity to learn about a very unusual ministry in a very unique way.

Andi and Al Tauber who comprise the husband-wife singing duo known as *andi and i*, will be coming to Grace to share through songs and storytelling their work with Emmaus Ministries in Chicago. Emmaus Ministries works with a group of guys whose stories are rarely heard by anyone who can offer them hope. While we safely sleep, they walk streets we don't visit, selling themselves to survive.

Though the stories come from Chicago's streets, similar stories are being told in cities all across the country. These prodigal sons need hope, and the people who can offer it—people who know Jesus' story—don't know they exist.

That is why Andi and Al are coming to Grace—to share the stories of these troubled men with us.
